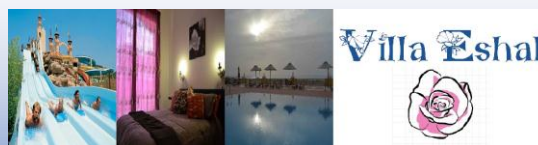
The course was excellent (if a little confusing to us senior citizens) and (I hope) thoroughly enjoyed by all competitors.
